



Take a Ten Toes Express Trip to Emma Kunz House

TOTAL WALK DISTANCE: 0.6 mile from MetroBus; 1.3 miles from MetroLink

Built around 1830, the Emma Kunz Home is the oldest Greek Revival home in Belleville that now acts as a museum. Relocated from Washington Street in 1972, this home is the perfect way to experience how a middle class 19th century family might have lived. Opened by appointment. Opened 2nd Sunday of the month 2-4. Point of contact is the St. Clair County Historical Society.

Directions from MetroLink:

- Take MetroLink to Swansea Station
- Walk to Swansea Loop at MetroLink
- Transfer to MetroBus #16 toward St. Clair Square

Directions from MetroBus:

- Take MetroBus #16 toward St. Clair Square to College MetroLink Station (runs every half hour).
- Exit MetroBus #16 at N. Charles Street.
- Walk south on N. Charles Street.
- Turn left at E. Main Street.
- Turn a right at Mascoutah Avenue.
- Make a short left on Lincoln St. then a quick right to continue on Mascoutah Avenue.
- Follow Mascoutah to Fulton Street.
- Make a right at Fulton Street. You will see the Emma Kunz House on the right.
- End walk at 602 Fulton Street.
- Retrace your steps to return to MetroBus stop.
