



Visit the Beautiful SIUE Gardens on the Ten Toe Express

Total Walk Distance: 1.5 - 3 miles

The Gardens at SIUE is a 35-acre public botanical garden on the campus of Southern Illinois University Edwardsville. Recognized by the Missouri Botanical Garden as a Signature Garden, The Gardens currently includes natural areas, gardens, and sculpture arranged in a landscaped setting. A one-half mile-long walking path meanders through woodlands and across grasslands to connect visitors with nature and gardens.

Directions:

- Take Madison County Transit bus #17 to the bike and bus connection at Goshen Trail.
- Exit the bus at the University & Esic. Walk north to the Goshen Trail.
- Follow the Goshen Trail North for a 1.5 mile distance.
- Make a left at Delyte W. Morris Trail.
- The Gardens will be on the left, at the intersection of University Dr. and Cougar Lake Rd. on SIUE's campus.
- Walk .5 mile walking path through the beautiful gardens.
- Take MCT #17 at Circle Drive at Delyte W. Morris Trail for your return trip.

For Fewer Steps:

- Exit MCT at Circle Dr. instead to shorten walk by 1.5 miles.
