

Ten Toes Express to Cherokee Street

TOTAL WALK DISTANCE: 1.1 miles or less

“Historic Antique Row” on Cherokee Street is a destination for collectors, curiosity-seekers, and history buffs. Various shops offer collectibles of every description. Plaques on restored buildings present a self-guided tour of this old neighborhood.

Directions:

- Take the MetroLink to Civic Center Station, then transfer to #73 Carondelet southbound.
- Exit the MetroBus near Cherokee & Lemp. Begin your walk on the northeast corner of Cherokee and Lemp.
- Walk west on Cherokee for six blocks to Jefferson. (This completes .38 miles)
- Retrace your steps on the other side of the street, completing .75 miles.

To Increase Your Steps:

- Continue east on Cherokee two blocks to DeMenil Place. You will see the former Lemp Brewery on your right.
- Turn left on DeMenil Place. The historic DeMenil Mansion, a museum and restaurant, is on your right.
- Walk north to Utah passing the “haunted” Lemp Mansion, also a restaurant.
- Check out the view across I-55 to St. Agatha Church and the A-B Brewery.
- Turn left on Utah to return to Lemp. You will see Cherokee Park on your right.
- Turn right on Lemp to reach the bus-stop next to the Park.
- Return to MetroLink on the #73 northbound.
