

Take the Ten Toes Express to Francis Park

TOTAL WALK DISTANCE: 1.85 miles or less

Francis Park in the St. Louis Hills neighborhood offers wide open space in a peaceful tree-shaded neighborhood. There are no hills! The land was a gift to St Louis City from David Francis, director of the 1904 World's Fair. Residential development began in the 1930's. The park is almost square with a church at every corner. A complete walk around the park is 1.25 miles but you may shorten it .25 mile by cutting across the middle. The park is a short ride bus ride away from Shrewsbury Station and .3 mile from Ted Drewes custard stand.

Directions:

- Take MetroLink to Shrewsbury Station, then transfer to MetroBus #11 Chippewa eastbound.
- Exit the bus in front of Ted Drewes on Chippewa.
- Walk west (backtrack) on Chippewa half a block to Prather.
- Turn left on Prather. Take Prather til it ends on Nottingham then turn left.
- Follow Nottingham to Donovan. St. Thomas Orthodox is on your left.
- Continue on Nottingham to Tamm. St Gabriel the Archangel RC is ahead on your left.
- Turn right on Tamm to Eichelberger. Hope United CC is ahead on your left.
- Turn right on Eichelberger to Donovan. Ascension Lutheran is on your left.
- Return to Nottingham and retrace your steps to Chippewa. Enjoy a treat at Ted Drewes - but be sure to finish it before you board your bus.
- Cross Chippewa to board #11 westbound to Shrewsbury Station.
