



Take the Ten Toes Express to the Heart of Webster

TOTAL WALK DISTANCE: .8 or 1.25 miles

Downtown Webster is home to small businesses offering personal services and special products not available in shopping malls. Many of the storefronts have been in use for generations. You can enjoy this friendly atmosphere for a short stroll or a long walk, starting at Lockwood & N. Gore.

Directions:

- Take MetroLink to Shrewsbury Station, then transfer to #56 Kirkwood-Webster. Begin your walk from the northeast corner of Lockwood and N. Gore.
- Walk east on Lockwood for one block to Elm. You will see the Presbyterian Church on your left.
- Cross Lockwood at Elm. You will see City Hall across Elm on your left. Return to N. Gore to complete .25 mile.

OR:

- Continue west on Lockwood, heading west four blocks to Rock Hill.
- Cross Lockwood at Rock Hill.
- Return to N. Gore to complete another .55 mile.

For an Added Challenge:

- Walk north down-hill on N. Gore toward the railroad tracks. Webster developed along the railroad during the 19th century where several old buildings remain.
 - Cross the railroad tracks to continue to W. Kirkham.
 - Cross W. Kirkham, staying on Gore. Walk up-hill on Gore to return to Lockwood, completing another .45 mile.
 - Board the #56 eastbound on S. Gore across from Webster Books as it completes a loop from Kirkwood.
- If you choose to shorten this walk by crossing at other intersections, please note that cross-walks may not be available!*
