# Visit Jefferson Barracks County Park on the Ten Toe Express

## TOTAL WALK DISTANCE: 1-4 miles

Jefferson Barracks served the US military in several capacities 1826 - 1946. It was of strategic importance for its location south of St Louis above the Mississippi River. The site is now used by the Missouri National Guard; a Veterans Hospital and National Cemetery are south of the Barracks. North of the Barracks is a County Park of over 400 acres containing historic buildings, recreational facilities, and hiking trails for the edification and enjoyment of everyone. Bring a picnic and spend the day! (Call 314-544-5714 for more information - museum buildings open Wed. - Sun.)

## **Directions:**

- Take MetroLink to Civic Center, then transfer to MetroBus #40 southbound.
- Exit the bus on Broadway at Ripa (traffic light), just before Broadway in St. Louis becomes Kingston Drive in St Louis County. Cross to the east side of the street.
- Enter the Park through the gates ahead on your left. Walk straight along Grant Road.
- Take the second left, North Road, if you wish to go to the Visitors'
- Center, .5 mile from the bus stop. Some museum buildings are up on the bluff beyond the Center.

#### OR:

• Turn right on Cye Rd. to access the Schick Trail, a loop portion of 2.7 miles of paved trails through the Park (restrooms and maps are here at the Trailhead).

## OR:

• Stay on Grant Road to Scenic Circle Drive to reach the overlook 1.12 miles from the bus stop - see map.
