

Jewel Box on the Ten Toe Express

Total Walk Distance: 1.35 miles one-way

The Jewel Box is an Art Deco greenhouse in Forest Park listed on the National Historic Register. It contains horticultural displays all year and special seasonal flower shows. The landscaped site surrounding it includes the Korean War Memorial. It is located mid-way for pedestrians between CWE and Forest Park Metro Stations. Walking from the CWE shows you features of the park not seen from the highway and gives you access to the park's newest restaurant, The Highlands. You will find this a good route to The Great Forest Park Balloon Race every September.

Directions:

- Exit MetroLink at CWE Station and take the stairs or elevator to the Medical Center. Turn left. Walk south to Barnes Hospital Plaza and turn left.
- Cross the street and continue south alongside the little piece of Forest Park east of Kingshighway. A playground and tennis courts are on your right.
- Turn right alongside Clayton Avenue. Follow the sidewalk under Kingshighway to re-enter the park.
- Continue westward, crossing the bike path to the science center and then passing the Planetarium on your left. The Highlands Golf and Tennis Center is on your right.
- Turn right at McKinley Drive and immediately bear right on Wells Drive to reach the Jewel Box.

To Decrease Your Steps:

- Between Memorial Day and Labor Day the Jewel Box is a stop on the Forest Park Shuttle. The rest of the year the nearest MetroBus stops are #59 on Oakland or #90 on Hampton.
