

Step out on the Ten Toe Express to the Labor and Industry Museum

TOTAL WALK DISTANCE: 0.085 mile from MetroBus; 0.7 mile from MetroLink

The Labor and Industry Museum stands as the only public institution to display the history of Belleville and southern Illinois labor and industry. Housed in a structure built in 1837, this museum truly depicts how Belleville contributed significantly to the age of industry in the United States. This museum which shows how southwestern Illinois was constructed is something you won't want to miss!

Directions from MetroLink:

- Take MetroLink to Belleville Station
- Walk to the Belleville Loop at the MetroLink
- Transfer to MetroBus #1 to Main St. State St.

Directions from MetroBus:

- Take MetroBus #1 toward Belleville MetroLink Station (runs every half hour).
- Exit MetroBus #1 at N. Charles Street.
- Walk south on N. Charles Street.
- Turn right onto EB Street.
- Make a quick left onto Church Street. The Labor & Industry Museum on the corner of Church and EB Street.
- End walk at 123 N. Church Street
- Retrace your steps to return to the MetroBus stop
