



Take a trip to the History Museum Library & Research Center on the Ten Toe Express

Total Walk Distance: *1 mile*

Visit the Missouri History Museum Library and Research Center to search the collections, including a genealogy index, library catalog, and archives guides. The Library holds over 90,000 books, periodicals, newspapers, maps, and microfilms, including St. Louis area newspapers and directories dating back to 1821. The Library and Research Center is open Tuesday-Friday, 12p.m. to 5p.m. and Saturday 11a.m.-5p.m.

Directions:

- Take MetroLink to the Skinker station.
- Exit MetroLink on N. Skinker.
- Head south on N. Skinker toward Lindell Blvd, walking 0.5 miles.
- Museum will be on the right.

For Additional Steps:

- Exit at Forest Park MetroLink station.
- Head north toward Pershing Ave. and turn left onto De Baliviere Ave., make a right toward Skinker.
- Walk for approximately one mile, make a slight right toward Skinker.
- When you reach Skinker, turn left, the museum will be on the right.
- Head back to either station for return trip.
