



Enjoy the Soulard Market Neighborhood on the Ten Toe Express

Total Walk Distance: .75 mile or 1.25 miles

Soulard Market has been a St. Louis City public market since 1845, when it was a “shopping center” for thousands of immigrants. The streets to the south, settled mostly by Germans, retain the appearance of that pre-automobile era: churches, schools, taverns, and places of business are all within walking distance of houses.

Directions:

- Take MetroLink to Civic Center Station, then transfer to MetroBus #30 Soulard-St Louis southbound.
- Exit the bus at 7th & LaFayette, right in front of the Market. Walk west to 8th Street and turn left
- Follow 8th Street three blocks to Allen Street and turn right to 9th Street. Turn right on 9th to complete a ¾ mile loop.

Additional Walk:

- If you wish to add another half-mile, turn left on 9th Street for two blocks, make a circuit of Pontiac Park before you return to the Market.

Add Some Steps:

- The market covers two city blocks. Explore all four wings.
