



Visit UMSL - North Campus on the Ten Toe Express

TOTAL WALK DISTANCE: 1 mile or more

The University of Missouri is home to the magnificent Touhill Performing Arts Center (TPAC), a short walk from MetroLink at the UMSL North Station. UMSL is also home to the Mercantile Library, a collection of books, art, and artifacts established in 1846 by St. Louis businessmen. It continues to be enriched by thoughtful donors. Rotating exhibits are free and open to the public. The entrance is less than .5 mile from the train.

Directions to TPAC:

- Exit the train to your left and follow the sign on your right to TPAC. The entrance is less than .2 mile from the train.

Directions to Mercantile Library:

- Exit the train to your left. Walk past Gallery 210 and cross the drive leading to TPAC. Continue toward the large building straight ahead of you beyond the parking lots. This is the Millennium Student Center.
- Follow the crosswalk to the MSC and walk straight through. You are on the middle of three levels.
- Turn right past the student radio station onto the pedestrian bridge.
- Exit the bridge and turn left into the university quadrangle. The back of the Library is ahead of you at the far side of the quadrangle. (Note the glass pyramid structure to the right of the Library, which is the atrium for the Mercantile.)
- Walk around the Library, turning left then right, to reach the main entrance. The Thomas Jefferson University Library is on the entrance level. The Mercantile is down the stairs or elevator to your left.
- Return to MetroLink by exiting the Library to your left, turning right then left, winding downhill through the landscaped campus. Enter the MSC on the ground level.
