



Take a stroll down Washington Avenue to City Museum on the Ten Toe Express

TOTAL WALK DISTANCE: 1.5 miles

City Museum defies description - a playground for children of all ages made of artfully constructed cast-offs from our industrial past. See for yourself and plan to come back to spend a few hours with the youngsters in your life. This walk uses two MetroLink stations but you may cover the same distance by using either station and retracing your steps.

Directions:

- Exit MetroLink at Convention Center Station (6th & Washington). Turn right at the top of the escalator or stairs to walk west on lively Washington Avenue. The Convention Center itself is ahead on your right.
- Continue west to 16th St. (10 blocks).
- You may use this walk to view a display loft, dine in a pub, or shop in a specialty store.
- Turn right on 16th. Walk one block to Lucas Place to view the outside of the Museum.
- You may walk into the Museum to view children at play but you must pay an entrance fee to visit all that this extraordinary destination has to offer.
- Exit the Museum on Lucas Place at 15th St. Turn right on 15th to return to Washington. Turn left on Washington then right on 14th St.
- Follow 14th St. south to Clark St. (7 blocks). This route takes you past several civic landmarks you may enjoy on another walk.
- Return to MetroLink at Civic Center station.

To Save Steps:

- MetroBus #99, the “Downtown Trolley”, connects Civic Center and Convention Center Stations, via City Museum and Washington Avenue. It runs every 10 minutes.
