



Come and See the St. Louis Zoo from Forest Park Station on the Ten Toe Express

TOTAL WALK DISTANCE: 1.25 miles to North Entrance (one-way)
The marvelous FREE St Louis Zoo may be reached by walking through Forest Park to the Living World educational center at the North Entrance. A cafeteria and restrooms are located here.

Directions:

- Ride MetroLink to Forest Park Station.
- Walk south toward the History Museum.
- Pass the History Museum on your left and follow the path parallel to Lagoon Drive. The Tennis Courts are to your left and the Golf Course is to your right.
- Turn left at the bottom of the Grand Basin. Walk south facing the Art Museum.
- Turn left at the foot of Art Hill. Continue walking toward Government Drive.
- Turn right on Government Drive to reach the Zoo entrance at the Living World.

For an Additional .5 mile:

- Cross Government Drive to walk uphill on Washington Drive. The Bird Cage is on your right.
- Turn right on Concourse Drive. Continue uphill to view the multi-figured “Animals Always” sculpture.
- Turn right on Wells Drive to reach the South Entrance of the Zoo

For an Additional .25 mile or more:

- Walk through the Zoo Between the Living World and South Entrance.

If you tire of walking you may return to MetroLink on MetroBus #90 northbound or on the Forest Park Shuttle which runs every 15 minutes Memorial Day through Labor Day.
